What is Active Legal Cases per Billion Dollars of Revenue?

The total number of pending (active cases that have not yet been closed/settled) legal cases divided by each one billion dollars of revenue earned by the company over the same period of time.

Why should this KPI be measured?

Active Legal Cases per Billion Dollars of Revenue measures the total number of pending (active cases that have not yet been closed/settled) legal cases in relation to each one billion dollars of revenue earned by

How is this KPI calculated?

Two values are used to calculate this KPI: (1) the total number of pending legal cases, and (2) each one billion dollars of revenue earned by the company. The total case should be
