What is Cost per Payroll Payment?

The total amount of expense incurred by the Payroll function divided by the number of payroll payments processed over the same period of time. Total Payroll function expense should include all labor, technology and other overhead costs related to running the Payroll function.

Why should this KPI be measured?

Cost per Payroll Payment measures how much, on average, the Payroll function spends to process a single payroll payment. A high unit cost for processing a single payroll payment may be related to several

How is this KPI calculated?

Two values are used to calculate this KPI: (1) total expense incurred by the Payroll function; and (2) the number of payroll payments processed over the same period of time. Total Payroll function expense should
