What is Managed Spend per Procurement Employee?

The total dollar amount the Procurement function has spent on purchases divided by the number of employees working within the Procurement function over the same period of time.

Why should this KPI be measured?

Managed Spend per Procurement Employee measures the total dollar amount which the Procurement function has spent on purchases in relation to the number of employees working for the Procurement

How is this KPI calculated?

Two values are used to calculate this KPI: (1) the total dollar amount the Procurement function has spent on purchases; and (2) the number of employees working for the Procurement function over the same
