What is Number of Annual Budget Iterations?

The number of budget submissions made during the annual budget process before the budget's final approval.

Why should this KPI be measured?

Number of Annual Budget Iterations measures both the accuracy of the budget production process and the efficiency of the budget approval process. A higher than average value for this metric may be attributed

How is this KPI calculated?

Count the number of instances in which a submitted company budget is revised and resubmitted before being finalized and approved. Budget revisions may be required due to significant changes throughout the
